





Total migration flows to OECD countries and the Russian Federation, 1990-2010, thousands




Permanent-type immigration by main category as a % of the total population, 2009

2000-10 occupational change, by growth quintile and demographic group




Expected net change in the working-age population over the period 2005-2020, at 2001-2005 net migration levels, as % 2005 population
